School Store is an online shopping program that helps schools earn money with every day shopping. We have over 400 vendors that work with us to give money back to schools. We use an email campaign with the students to get the program started. We provide all materials at no cost to the school. We will print parent letters, provide a kick off video & turn in day prizes for students that participate.

Students take home a parent letter & with mom & dad's help send out email invitations to friends and family about shopping online. Those emails go out w/ a link to the school's site where people can shop with merchants like Wal-Mart, Kohl's, Verizon, etc and the school receives UPTO 50% back from these merchants. It varies merchant to merchant what percentage they give back. I do not have a printable list of all merchants; but I've attached a top 100 merchants list.

When students send email invitations they are issued a prize code to return to school for a turn in day prize. At that point the school's part of the program to get it started is complete and there is no more to do.


We provide an online reports page that the contact at the school can use to see how much money the school is earning, what students have participated, and to request a check. We do automatically send a check at the 30 day mark for any monies earned so far. After that time the school can request a check at any time.

One of the merchants, The Family Bookstore, does provide a prize program for students that participate. If they receive orders from that particular merchant they earn prizes on a prize thermometer. Those are periodically shipped to the school prepacked by student for easy distribution. The prize program runs for the course of the school year.

One of the purchase options online is a Caring for Classrooms online voucher. This part of the program is optional. If schools run the program without those vouchers there will be NO mention of them on any materials, emails or the website.

We can have 1 point of contact for purposes of taking care of the contract; but we assign schools to different program schedulers & program coordinators so we can not guarantee that once a school has signed up that they will wall be working with the same person.
