CUSTOMER SERVICE AGREEMENT TERMS

REQUIREMENTS SUPPLIED, Customer orders from UniFest Corp. ("LiniFest") the rental garments and/or other items of the type specified in this Agreement ("Merchandise") and related pickupidelivery and maintenance services (collectivaty with Merchandise, Survices") for all of Customer's requirements therefor, at the prices and upon the terms and conditions set forth between Additional Services requested by Customer, verhally or in writing, will also be covered by this Agreement. All rental Merchandise supplied to Customer remains the property of UniFirst. Customer werrants that it is not subject to, and that this Agreement does not interfere or conflict with, any existing agreement for the supply of the Marchandise or Services covered

PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE. UNIFIRST GUARANTEES TO DELIVER HIGH-QUALITY SERVICE AT ALL TIMES, All floms of Merchandise cleaned, finished, inspected. repaired, and delivered by UniFirst will meet or exceed industry standards, or non-centaming items will be replaced by the next scheduled delivery day at no cost to Customer, items of realst Merchantics requiring replacement due to normal wear and that will be replaced at no cost to Customer, save for any applicable personalization and setup charges.

Customor expressly walves the right to terminate this Agreement during the tablet term or any extension thereof for deficiencies in the quality of Services unless; (1) complaints are first made in writing to UniFirst which set forth the precise nature of any deficiencies; (2) UniFirst is alforded at least 60 days to correct any deficiencies complained of; and (3) UniFirst fails to correct those deficiencies complained of within 60 days, in the event Customer complies with the foregoing and UniFirst fails to correct such deficiencies. Customer may forminate this Agreement by written notice to UniFirst, providing that all previous balances due to UniFirst have been pald in full and that all other conditions. to terminate have been satisfied. Any delay or interruption of the Services provided for in this Agreement by reason of acts of God, fires, explosions, strikes or other industrial disturbances, or any other cause not within the control of Unifirest, shall not be deemed a breach or violation of this Agreement.

TERM AND RENEWAL. This Agreement is diffective when signed by both the Costomer and Unifirst Location Manager and continues in effect for 60 months after installation. of Morchandiso (for new customers) or any renewal date. This Agreement will be renewed automatically and continuously for multiple successive 60-month periods unless Customer or Uniffest gives written notice of non-renewal to the other at least 90 days prior to the next expiration date.

PRICES AND PAYMENTS, Prices are based on 52 weeks of service per year. Any increase(s) to Service Frequency could result in additional charges. On an annual basis, the prices then in utfect will be increased by the greater of the annual percent line case in the Consumer Price Index. All Urban Consumers, Series ID: CUUROOOSAG, other goods and sorvices, or by 55s. Additional price increases and other charges may be imposed by separate written notice or by notation or Customer's Invoice, Customer may, harvover, deather acreated as each engine to whether utfers or harder and additional price increases or charges to be noticed or half-irst in meting within 10 days within 10 days eth notice or notation. If Customer declines said additional price increases, UniFirst may terminate this Agreement. Customer also agrees to pay the other charges and minimum weekly charge herein specified, Charges relating to a warrer leaving Customer's employ can be forminated by (1) giving notice thereof to durifinat and (2) returning or paying for any missing Marchandise issued to that individual. Any Marchandso payments required pursuant to his Agreement will be at the replacement price(s) then in effect herounder. If an authorized Customer representative is not available to receive and acknowledge delivery of Marchanusco, Customer authorizes UniFirst to make delivery and assumes responsibility for related charges/involces.

If Customer (alls to make timely payment, UniFirst may, at any time and in its sole discretion, familinate this Agreement by giving written notice to Customer, whether or not UniFirst has proviously strictly enforced Customer's obligation to make timely payments. Customer agrees to pay, and will pay, all applicable sales, use, personal property, and other laxes and assessments arising out of this Agreement.

DEFE CHARGE, Customer's Invoices may also include a DEFE charge to cover all or portions of certain expenses including:

- D = DELIVERY, or expenses associated with the actual delivery of Services and Merchandise to Customer's place of business, primarily Route Sales Representative commissions, management salaries, vehicle depreciation, equipment maintenance, insurance, road use charges and local access fees.
- E = ENVIRONMENTAL, or expensos (past, prosont, and future) UncFrist abscript related to wastewater testing, purification, efficient control, solids disposal, supplies and equipment for pollution controls and energy conservation, and overall regulatory compliance.
- F = FUEL, or the gas, diesel fuel, oil, and lubricant expenses associated with keeping UniFirst's fleet vehicles on the road and servicing its sustemers.
- E = ENERGY, primarily the natural gas UniFirst uses to run boilers and gos dryers, plus other local utility charges.

MERCHANDISE. Customer acknowledges and agrees to notify all employees that Marchandise supplied is for general occupational use and, except as expressly specified below, alfords no special stree protections. Costomer further acknowledges that: (1) Customer has unitaterally and independently detarmined and selected the nature, style, performance characteristics, number of changes and scope of all Marchandise to be used and the appropriateness of such Marchandise for Customer's specific needs or intended uses; (2) Unifier tools not be only only obligation to advise, and then not advised. Customer concerning the fitness or suitability of the Marchandise for Customer's infended use; (2) Unifiers that it no way to be proposable or leads to the notation of the marchandise (including without similation Flamo Resistant and Visibility Merchandise); and (1) Unifierst shall it no way be responsible or habte for any injury or harm suffered by any Customer employees while weeding or using any Marchandise. Customer agrees to Indomnially and hold harmless Unifierst and its employees and against from and against all claims, injuries, or damages to any person or property resulting from Customer's employee use of the Marchandise, whether or not such claims, Injuries or damages arise from any alleged defects in the Marchandise.

Flame Resistant (FR') Merchandise supplied hereunder is intended only to prevent the ignition and burning of fabric away from the point of high heal impingement and to be self-extinguishing upon removal of the ignition source. The Visibility Merchandise supplied satisfed particular AVSIVISEA standards uply when they were now and unused and only if so labeled. Customer acknowledges that usage and taundering of Visibility Merchandise may adversely affect its conspicuity.

Healthcaraff-ood-Related Customer acknowledges that: (1) Unifical does not guarantee or warrant that the Merchandise selected by Customer or that processed garments delivered by Unificat will be appropriate or sufficient to provide a hygienic level adequate for individual Customer's needs; and (2) optional poly-bagging* is recommended to reduce the risk of cross-contamination of Merchandise, and the folium to utilize such convice may adversely affect the efficacy of Unifirst's hygienic cleaning process. If any Morchandise supplied hereunder is Morchandise that (1) Uniffest does not slock for whatever reason (including due to style, color, size or brand); (2) consists of non-Uniffest manufactured or customized ER Morchandise; or (3) cornists of Morchandise that has been permanently personalized (in all cases known as "Non-Standard Morchandise"), then, upon the discontinuance of any Service hereunder at any time for any coason, including expiration, termination, or cancellation of this Agreement, with office as the standard Morchandise from Customer's Service Program, or due to employee reductions (in each case a "Discontinuance of Service"). Customer will putchase at the time of such Discontinuance of Service at all elected Rem-Standard Morchandise terms then in Uniffers's inventory (in-service, shelf, as well as any manufacturer's supplies ordered for Customer's use), paying for same the replacement charges than in effect.

Customer agrees not to contaminate any Microhandise with asbestes, heavy metals, solvents, links, or other hazardous or toxic substances ("contaminants"). Customer agrees to pay UniFirst for all Microhandise that is tost, stolen, damaged or obused basenal repair. As a condition to the termination of this Agreement, for wholever reason, Customer will return to UniFirst all standard Microhandise in good and usable condition or pay for same at the replacement charges then in effect.

OBLIGATIONS AND REMEDIES. If Coulomer breaches of terminates this Agreement before the expiration date for any reason (other than for UniFirst's fallure under the performance guarantee described above). Customer will pay UniFirst, as benefited damages and not as a penalty (the parties acknowledging that actual damages would be difficult to calculate with reasonable containty) an amount equal to 50 percent of the average weekly amounts invoiced in the preceding 26 weeks, multiplied by the number of weeks remelating in the current term. Those damages will be in addition to all other obligations or amounts owed by Customer to UniFirst, including the return of Standard Merchandise or payment of replacement charges, and the purchase of any Non-Standard Merchandise items as set forth herein.
