A. Reason for the Deregulation request. Please include circumstances which necessitate changing the standard of library services for your size of school, what alternative means will have to be employed if your waiver was to be denied?

Broken Arrow Public Schools is requesting a Statutory Waiver/Deregulation of OAC 210:35-5-71 Library Media Services for Timber Ridge Elementary regarding media center staffing. Due to public school funding constraints, we request to employ one full-time certified library media specialist with no assistant.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.
 - BAPS/Timber Ridge Elementary is committed to serving our students with library media services that enhance student achievement and reading literacy. Timber Ridge has a wealth of parent volunteers who graciously donate their time and talent in the media center. In the rare event that a volunteer is not available, office staff will rotate to help with library coverage. All parties have been trained to handle tasks that would have been performed by a library assistant. Duties like shelving books, checking books in and out, assisting with students, traveling with the book cart, cataloging new media materials, escorting students and performing minor book repair will be done by our volunteers or office staff.

 Janice Buchanan, media specialist, works with all classes during the week as part of our specials rotation. Should the waiver be denied, funding from various programs supporting literacy, RTI, instruction and diverse student needs would likely be pulled to fund the assistant salary.
- C. Has this deregulation been awarded before? If so what was the educational impact to the district: Results of the Deregulation, i.e., effect on student performance levels, impact of plan on other sites in the district. If not what do you expect?

Yes. Timber Ridge Elementary was awarded this deregulation last year. Student performance did not suffer due to the elimination of the library assistant position. Scores on OSTP, STAR, Literacy Now, NSGRA, RSA and formative assessments continued to show progress with literacy skills and were on target with what was expected. Since many sites in the district are requesting this deregulation, any impact would be equal across the district.
