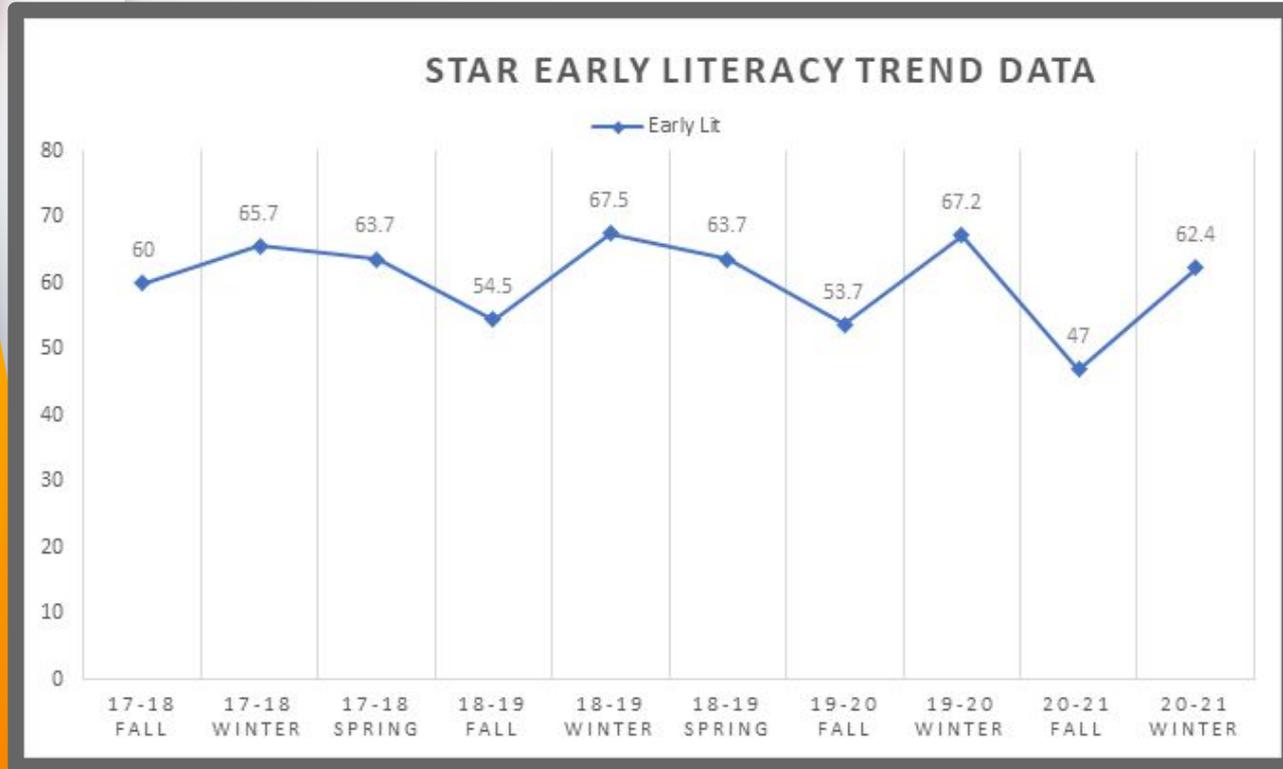

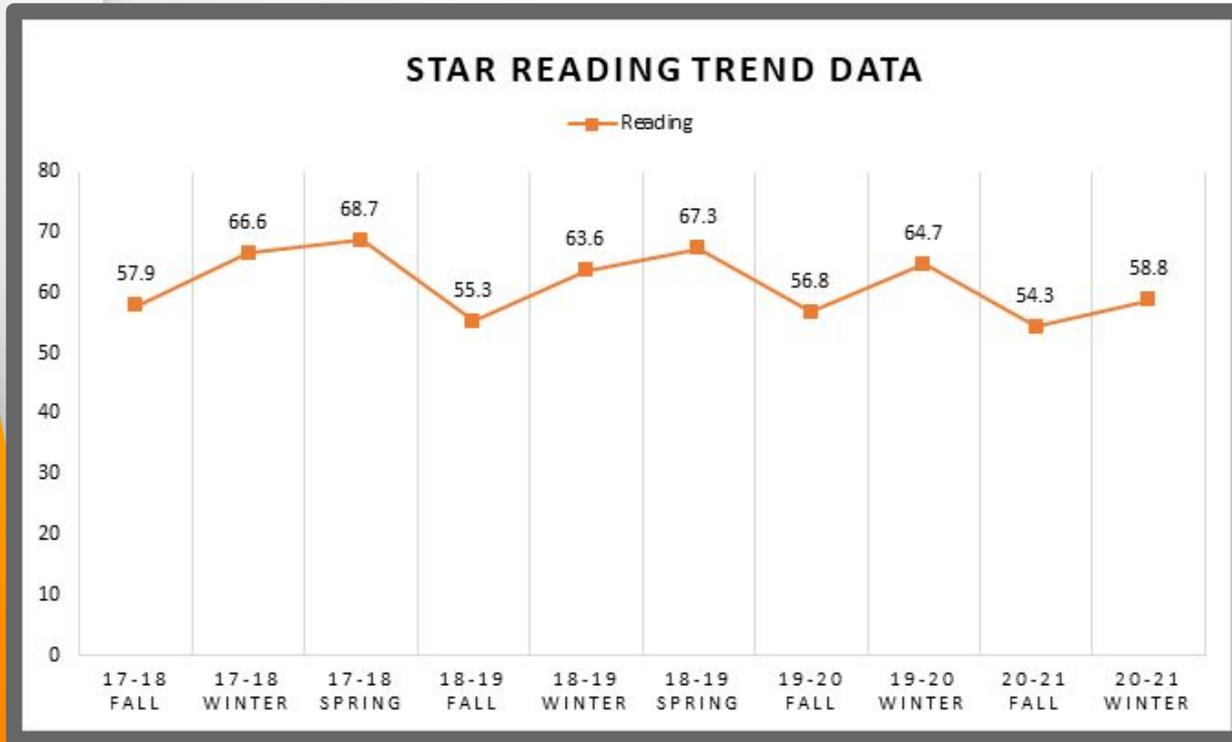

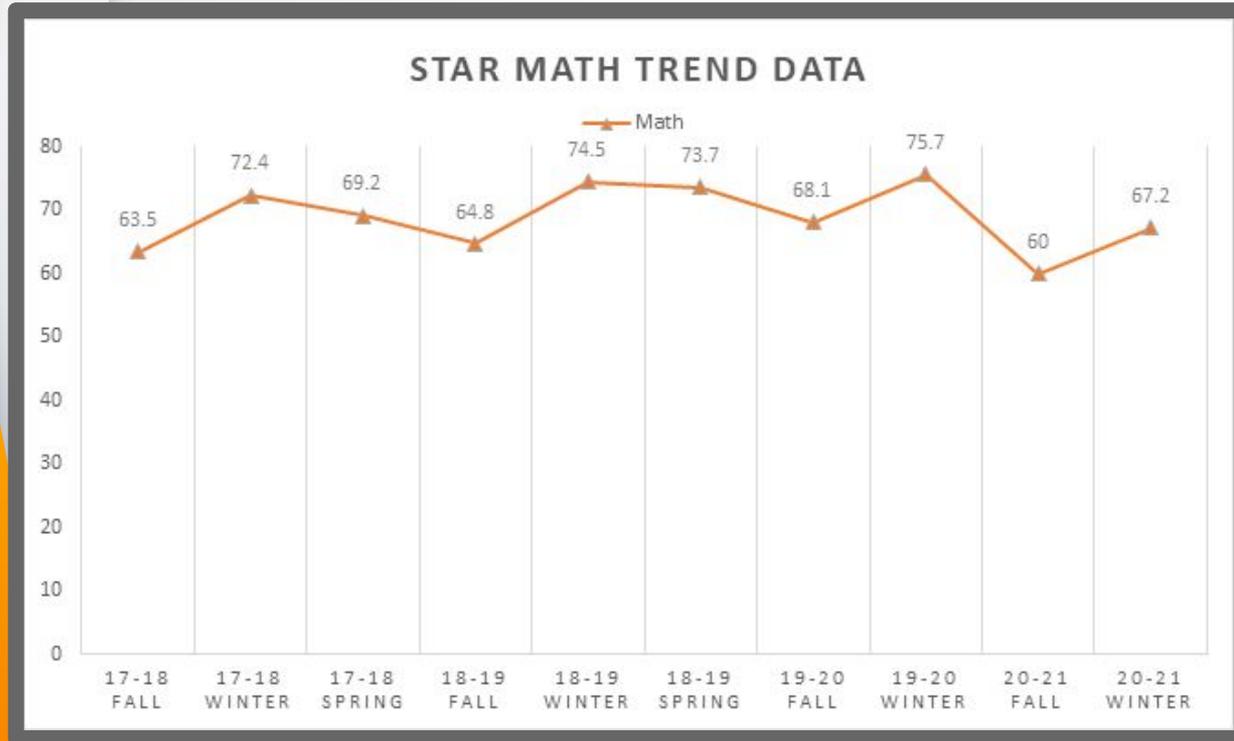

 - We purchased **Hegerty Phonemic Awareness** curriculum for every PreK-1st grade classroom, Special Education classrooms, and Interventionists.
 - We purchased **Next Step Forward in Word Study and Phonics**
 - Professional Development for interventionists is underway.
 - Professional Development for classroom teachers in 2021-2022 SY
 - Professional Development on readiness skills for PreK/Kindergarten
- Conduct site data meetings with site leaders to develop site plans
 - Identify PD needs
 - Identify site specific resources needed
- Instructional Coaches/Literacy Coaches/Academic Enrichment Specialists to work with individual teachers to identify ways to achieve instructional goals
