

Parent and Staff Mask Policy Survey Results


Mask Policy Survey

- A one question survey was sent to parents on Friday, September 24, 2021.
- Parents had until Friday, October 1, 2021 to complete the survey.
- Parents were allowed to cast a vote on a "per student" or "per child" basis. (i.e. One Student – One Vote.)
- We also offered a staff survey to get their input as well.




Survey Logistics

- Parents were asked to provide three different pieces of information when they submitted their vote:
 - Student ID
 - School Site
 - Grade Level
- Survey Question was in a yes/no format. (i.e. In Favor or NOT in favor)
- Are you in favor or not in favor of an Indoor Mask Policy requiring all students and staff to wear masks indoors, with the ability to "opt-out" based on medical, religious or strong personal beliefs?




Examining the Results

- Important to validate the results. That's why we asked for those pieces of information. Here are the steps used to validate the submissions:
- 1. Eliminate the responses with No Answer.
- 2. Use the parent provide data (i.e. Student ID, School Site, and Grade Level) to create a unique identifier for each vote.
- 3. Compare that provided data to data in the Student Information System to validate each vote.




Examining the Results (cont.)

- Steps Continued . . .
- 4. Remove the Invalid Votes.
- 5. Eliminate the Duplicate Votes.
- Reconcile the small number of votes cast that were both in favor <u>AND</u> not in favor of a mask policy.




PARENT SURVEY

39.08% In favor of mask policy




60.92% NOT in favor of mask policy
