## **DEREGULATIONS**

- OAC 210:35-5-71 <u>Library Media Services Elementary School</u> School is changing the standard of library services for their size school.
- OAC 210:35-7-61 <u>Library Media Services Middle School</u> School is changing the standard of library services for their size school.
- OAC 210:35-9-71 <u>Library Media Services Secondary School</u> School is changing the standard of library services for their size school.
- OAC 210:35-29-2 <u>Abbreviated Day Alternative Education</u> Use both citations for an alternative school to operate with abbreviated hours, less than four hours and 12 minutes of instruction per day, five days a week, or 756 hours per year.
- OAC 210:35-3-46 **Superintendent, Elementary & Secondary Principal certificate** serve as High School and Elementary School Principal with a school enrollment more than 500 (requires a dereg.)

NOTE: OAC 210:35-5-42 & 210:35-9-43 - Planning Period Deregulations, no longer requires a deregulation.

  - Broken Arrow Public Schools is requesting a Statutory Waiver/Deregulation of OAC 210:35-5-71 Library Media Services for Country Lane Primary regarding media center staffing. Due to public school funding constraints, we request to employ one full-time certified library media specialist with no assistant.

- B. List alternate strategies/plans which the site proposes, and how this plan will best serve the students of your district, i.e., a description of the educational benefits to the students and learning achievement and any negative impact if the waiver were to be denied.
  BAPS/Country Lane Primary will continue to serve our students with library media services that enhance student achievement and reading literacy. Country Lane Primary (CLP) will utilize parent volunteers in covering the duties that would be performed by a library assistant. In order for the media specialist to focus on student learning, volunteers will assist in tasks such as promoting books to student readers, checking books in and out, returning books to the shelves, and managing the front desk. Parent volunteers have proven to be vital in the operation of our media center. The same volunteers have been returning to our school for a number of years and understand media center procedures. Should the waiver be denied, funding from various programs supporting literacy, RTI, instruction and diverse student needs would likely be pulled to fund the

assistant salary.

Yes. CLP was granted a deregulation waiver in 2020-21 and the impact to student learning was minimal. Student performance level on benchmark testing was consistently at or above grade level and continued to show learning progression and mastery of concepts. With many sites in the district requesting deregulation, the impact should be equal.
