 - A. You may use the questionnaire(s) within this packet. Or you can customize your own questionnaire at our website: www.computer-fun.com. When you request posters, we will also send you 4 additional questionnaires. Also, you may cut and paste questions with any of the questionnaires.

B. Decide which matching program would work best with your school.

You may choose any one of the following 4 Programs

Program No. 1: Each student receives **TWO** printouts; they may purchase one or both printouts. One printout is all the same grade matches. The other printout matches the student from the remaining grades.

There is no duplication of matches on the two printouts.

WE RECOMMEND PROGRAM #1. Students like Program 1 because they have a **CHOICE** of printouts. Organizations like Program 1 because they make more money. **PARTICULARLY RECOMMENDED WHEN YOU SEND US 40 OR MORE ANSWER SHEETS PER GRADE.**

Program #1— Two printouts are sent to you for each student.
YOUR COST: 69 cents for EACH printout that you sell.
You pay us **ONLY** for the printouts that you sell. There are no other costs unless you ask us to mail the results back to you by overnight mail.

Program No. 2: Each student receives **ONE** printout. Girls are matched with boys two grades above them, their same grade and one grade below them. Boys are matched with girls two grades below them, their same grade and one grade above them.

Program No. 3: Each student receives **ONE** printout. We will match students with students of the opposite sex **FROM ONLY THEIR GRADE.** Seniors are matched with seniors, juniors with juniors and so on.

Program No. 4: Each student receives **ONE** printout. We will match students with all other students of the opposite sex regardless of grade.

Program #2, 3, 4— One printout is sent to you for each student.
YOUR COST: 75 cents for EACH printout that you sell.
You pay us **ONLY** for the printouts that you sell. There are no other costs unless you ask us to mail the results back to you by overnight mail.

- C. Decide if you want us to print the "THREE LEAST COMPATIBLE MATCHES" at the bottom of each student's printout. We recommend this; it will increase your sales and there is no additional charge.
- D. Decide if you want us to print the "THREE BEST FRIENDS MATCHES" (same sex) at the bottom of each student's printout. There is no additional charge.
- E. Decide if you want us to print the "THREE RANDOM MATCHES" at the bottom of each student's printout. There is no additional charge.
- F. Decide if you want the name of the sponsoring organization printed at the bottom of each student's printout.
- G. You have two types of printouts to choose from (see page 7). One type of printout is on an 8 1/2 x 11 inch sheet of paper with all the information easily seen (more attractive for scrapbooks). The other type of printout is folded and completely sealed (less work for large schools). See website for additional printout types.
- H. Decide how many matches each student should receive for the in-school matchup. You may choose 3 to 15 matches depending upon the size of your school (10 matches is most common). We recommend 5 matches for small schools.
- I. Decide if you want to include students' telephone numbers (we do not recommend) or homeroom numbers on the printouts.
- J. Decide if teachers can participate with students or only with other teachers. **SOMETIMES TEACHERS WILL USE FAKE NAMES SUCH AS: MICKEY MOUSE, DONALD DUCK, MR. K, MR. ZORRO, ETC.**
- K. Decide if you want to offer the "Heart-to-Heart" questionnaire for couples. This should be advertised separately and couples should fill out these questionnaires during lunch hour or before/after school. Note, the Heart-to-Heart questionnaire can be found at our website. Our charge is \$2 for each couple; we recommend that you charge \$4. Each couple receives two 3-page printouts describing where they are compatible, where they are not compatible and their rate of compatibility. Please staple couples' two answer sheets together before mailing to us.

5. COMMITTEE #2: ADVERTISING
- A. ALL CLUB MEMBERS SHOULD PROMOTE PROGRAM (TALK UP PROGRAM; SHOW EXCITEMENT; BE POSITIVE). It is very important to explain program to students (with posters and morning announcements).
 - B. Hang posters around the school; MAKE EXTRA POSTERS OF YOUR OWN.
 - C. GET EXTRA POSTERS FROM OUR WEBSITE.
 - D. MAKE MORNING PA ANNOUNCEMENTS (decide if you want Speech or Drama Department to help). See website for additional examples of morning announcements.
 - E. On Valentine's Day, give every girl a paper heart to wear (when she purchases a Computer Fun printout). If a male can get her to talk with him, she must then give him her heart. Or use a paper Shamrock, if you run the program on St. Patrick's Day.

6. COMMITTEE #3: COPY QUESTIONNAIRE
- A. TYPE OR WRITE THE NAME OF YOUR SCHOOL AT THE BOTTOM OF THE ANSWER SHEET BEFORE YOU PHOTOCOPY IT.
 - B. Duplicate questionnaire and answer sheet for all students.

7. COMMITTEE #4: HAVE STUDENTS FILL OUT QUESTIONNAIRES
- A. It is best to have students fill out questionnaires during morning announcements or English class. If this is not possible, have them complete questionnaires for three days during lunch periods. **DO NOT COLLECT ANY MONEY AT THIS TIME.**
 - B. Separate answer sheets by grade and by sex; put a rubber band around each bundle (no paper clips, please – they come off too easily). This is helpful for data entry workers and will increase accuracy of printouts.
 - C. Proofread answer sheets; make sure names are legible and a grade (8, 9, 10, 11, 12) is listed on every slip. Pull any "cute" or "obscene" names. Let us know if you have 2 or more students with the exact same name. Let us know if we should keep any unusual or funny names.

D. It is a good idea to WAIT TWO OR THREE DAYS before you mail the answers to us. Then you can include the answer sheets of students who were absent and the sheets that are turned in late. **THERE ARE ALWAYS LATE ANSWER SHEETS.**

8. COMMITTEE #5: MAILING
- A. CUT ANSWER SHEETS FROM QUESTIONNAIRES; then mail us only the answer sheets. This will save you postage and makes keying easier for data entry workers.
 - B. Be sure to mail us the COMPUTER FUN PROCESS FORM (Top of page 3).
 - C. To ensure that nothing is lost in the mail, SECURE YOUR PACKAGE COMPLETELY, USE PLENTY OF TAPE; IT IS A GOOD IDEA TO PUT YOUR ANSWER SHEETS IN A BOX or a tear-proof envelope.
 - D. Please put ALL answer slips in ONE box. If you want High School students separate from Junior High School students then put slips in separate envelopes inside the same box.
 - E. It is recommended to mail your packages by Priority Mail. Priority Mail normally takes 2 or 3 days from anywhere in the continental United States. Third Class or Library Rate usually takes several days longer. **THIS IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT WHEN YOU HAVE A SPECIFIC DEADLINE BY WHICH YOU NEED THE RESULTS.**
