Royalty prices are fixed and not affected by audience size or the cost of admission.

If necessary for production or competition, permission is granted to make small changes or cuts to the script, including combining or separating roles, as long as these changes do not impact the playwright's original intent. All other changes must be approved in advance by Pioneer Drama Service.

Changes to the production dates or the number of performances can easily be made by contacting Pioneer Drama Service.

Paper play and musical materials are neither returnable nor refundable. Paper scripts and other materials in brand new, resalable condition may be exchanged for a different Pioneer Drama Service play or musical. Return shipping is at the expense of the purchaser. Original shipping and handling fees will still apply. Electronic materials, including scripts, scores, director's books, music tracks, and graphics packages, are not returnable, refundable, or exchangeable.

For canceled performances, Pioneer Drama Service will fully refund paid royalties fees, less a 5% service fee for royalties refunded to a credit card, if notified within six months of the scheduled date of the first performance.
