# Memorandum of Understanding

The Bridges Foundation operates a classroom at <u>1813 Ash St Jenks</u>, <u>Ok</u> for the Work Adjustment Training Program. Students with disabilities attend class in the classroom setting for three hours daily each school day throughout the year.

Broken Arrow Public Schools desires to have students with disabilities participate in the Program during the 2022-2023 school year.

The school district desires to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to identify its rights and responsibilities governing the students' participation in the Program.

Therefore, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Bridges Foundation will ensure that all necessary special education procedures and parent consent have been obtained.
- 2. Broken Arrow Public Schools will not be charged for use of classroom space or participation in the Work Adjustment Training Program or the Transition Services.
- 3. Broken Arrow Public Schools will provide transportation to all BAPS students participating in the Work Adjustment Training Program and Transition Services.
- 4. Broken Arrow Public Schools will be responsible for ensuring a FAPE while participating in the Program.
- 5. The Memorandum of Understanding will terminate at the end of the 2022-2023 school year.
